## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

## between

## Asia Pacific University of Technology and Innovation (Malaysia) and

## Kogakkan University (Japan)

- 1. Asia Pacific University of Technology and Innovation and Kogakkan University, hereafter referred to as the parties, hereby conclude this Memorandum of Agreement. In a desire to develop academic exchange and cooperation in teaching and research in the furtherance of the advancement and dissemination of learning, the parties agree as follows:
  - (1) Based upon the principles of respect for each other's independence and mutual benefit, the parties agree to cooperate for the purpose of expanding students' opportunities for educational achievement, and the promotion of academic research by instructors and researchers.

The aforementioned cooperation may take the following general forms:

- a. Exchange programmes
- b. Intensive English programmes
- c. Semester programmes and Pre-University studies
- (2) In order to carry out any of the above activities, a detailed plan may be drawn up after consultation between the parties. Such a plan shall be the result of negotiation between the parties concerned in each specific case.
- (3) The parties shall comply with the laws of Japan and Malaysia, as well as the regulations of the other's institution regarding faculty and student exchanges both incoming and outgoing, the exchange of academic material and information, and joint programs.
- (4) This Agreement shall impose no financial obligation on either party.
- 2. This Agreement shall continue to be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date that the final signature is affixed. The Agreement may be extended for additional five-year periods upon the written consent of both parties. If the Agreement is not renewed by mutual consent, the Agreement will conclude at the end of the specified time period, or after activities in progress have concluded. The Agreement is subject to change or termination at any time by mutual consent or by six months' written notice by either party.
- 3. The parties shall each retain a signed copy of the English version of this Agreement, which is considered to be valid. Any translation in any other language shall be for reference only and shall not be considered binding by either party.
